The Kitchen Cherry Creek to open in August in Coda building

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The Kitchen restaurant will open in August in the [Coda building](#)

, a new new mixed-use development in Cherry Creek.

Kitchen Restaurant Group co-founders Hugo Matheson and Kimbal Musk said the new restaurant will look similar to their first, in Boulder, with wood floors, beamed ceilings and a central wood-burning oven for roasted meats and flatbreads.

The Kitchen Cherry Creek, at 100 Steele St., is a 4,500-square-foot space that will seat 125 people. There will be a trellis-covered patio for about 45 people, and an outdoor garden.

The Cherry Creek restaurant is part of the co-owners' [expansion plans](#) that include opening The Kitchen Next Door in Stapleton this fall. The Kitchen Restaurant Group currently [has eight locations](#), including an outpost in Chicago.
